9	Prince Edward Island	Beekeeping regulated under the <i>Animal Health and Protection Act</i> , Chapter A-11.1, "Bee Health Regulations" but the focus is on protecting genetics and health of provincial bees. Bee Health Certificate required. ix No fee.
10	Newfoundland & Labrador	Animal Health and Protection Act provides regulatory framework regarding honey bee health.* There is no mention of apiary registration in the Act. However, the provincial apiarist invites beekeepers to register on a voluntary basis.
